

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING A CAMERA-READY MANUSCRIPT

1 Instructions

Proceedings of the 19th Lomonosov Conference on Elementary Particle Physics (Moscow, Russia, August 22-28, 2019) will be collected in a special book entitled “Particle Physics at the Year of 150th Anniversary of the Mendeleev’s Periodic Table of Chemical Elements” edited by Alexander Studenikin) that will be published by World Scientific (Singapore) in 2020.

1.1 General Information

We are asking all authors to send us by e-mail the electronic version of their Proceedings contribution (an ASCII file using the $\text{\LaTeX} 2_{\epsilon}$ typesetting conventions for the text and figures in Postscript form). The \LaTeX file has to include appropriate commands to read and embed the figures ((Encapsulated) PostScript files) in the right place of the paper.

The electronic version of your manuscript should be sent to the Organizing Committee (use e-mail lomcon@phys.msu.ru) before **January 10, 2020**.

You should send us these files:

- **yourfamilyname.tex** — the main text of your paper (you can remove our sample text with instructions and replace it with your own contribution (paper) to the Proceedings, however we recommend to keep the original version of this file for reference);
- the **figures** that you use for compiling your manuscript;
- **final.pdf** version of your manuscript.

You should use the following \LaTeX style files:

- **19lomcon.sty** — this is a style file with the definition of font sizes, characters, line spacing, etc. (please do not change it!);

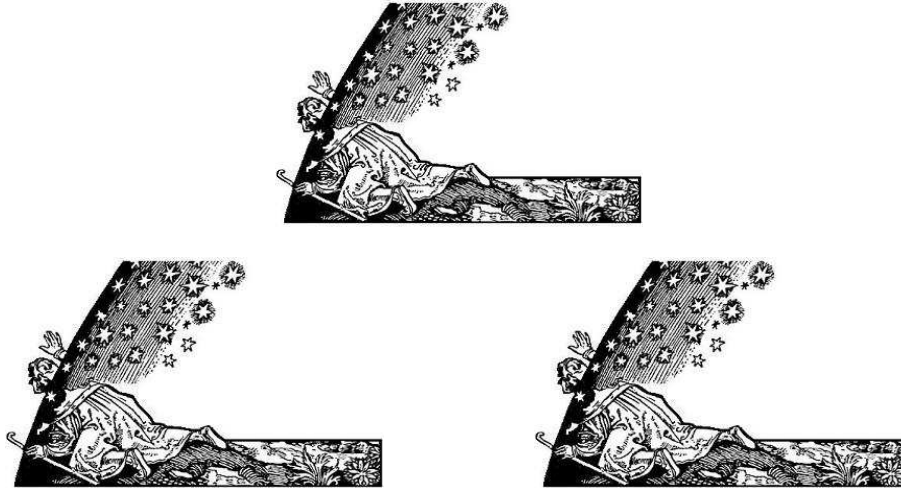


Figure 1: Text of the caption

- `cite.sty` — this is a style file with special service for making multi references.

In order to be acceptable, all contributions to the Proceedings should be prepared by the authors in the following form:

- the text size is 12×18 cm on ordinary A4-sized paper (please note that the page format as well as the size of characters and line spacing are set up automatically when you use our style file `18lomcon.sty` and `cite.sty`);
- on the front page, please place the title (in **CAPITAL LETTERS**), author's(s') name(s) (e.g., John Brown) with a complete mailing address including an e-mail address if available or desired, abstract and possible related footnotes;
- all the diagrams, figures, and related captions should be placed anywhere desired, provided that they are placed before the references; for some examples of how to insert (and adjust) figures into your text, please refer to the corresponding \TeX script of the present document;
- the names of files with figures should contain no more than EIGHT characters;
- footnotes should be typeset at the bottom of the page they are referred to on;
- please place acknowledgments at the end of the text before the references;

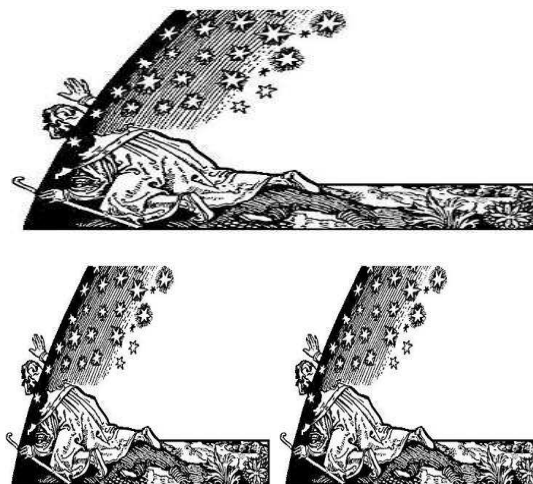


Figure 2: Figures

- references in the bibliography should be referred to in the text by a number in box brackets (e.g., [1], [1, 2], [1–3]) and the list of references must be located after the text and organized as shown in the References section below;
- pages of your camera-ready contribution must be **WITHOUT NUMBERS**.

The contribution length depends on the duration of the talk,

25 min	—	not more than 7 pages,
20 min	—	not more than 4 pages,
15 min	—	not more than 3 pages,
poster	—	not more than 2 pages.

The three files (`19lomcon.sty`, `cite.sty`, and `19lomcon.tex`) are available on our web site **www.icas.ru**.

Please note that this \LaTeX file with instructions for the authors also demonstrates how your paper should be organized (please take care of the font types used for the title of the paper, names of the authors, titles of sections and subsections, and also please follow our instructions on making the list of references).
